

BREXIT POLICY PANEL: Survey results

The Brexit Policy Panel is a survey of more than one hundred leading experts on Brexit from across the social sciences and provides a forecast of where Brexit is heading



91% of our experts think **Theresa May** will be able to **stay in office** to see Brexit through.

However, **71%** think she will be **gone by December 2020**.

On Northern Ireland, our panel now think that checks will be **'East-West' (40%)** rather than **'North-South' (29%)** or **no border (22%)**.



This is a change from last month's survey, when the expectation was that the principal border checks would be 'North-South'.


Academic experts think the chances of **Parliament passing Theresa May's Brexit deal** are in the balance: our panel give the Prime Minister a **53%** chance of passing the deal through the Commons..



The likelihood of **'Canada style'** deal has increased by 16 percentage points from last month's survey and now **stands at 58%**.



Our expert panel think a **referendum before 29 March** remains unlikely - they put the **chances of a second vote at 31%**.



Our panel's views on the likelihood of **'no deal'** has barely shifted since the poll was first conducted in July, and **stands at around 45%**.
